Membership

You'll need to present your membership card when signing up for trips. We've been a bit relaxed about this but for insurance purposes we must ensure that all participants on our trips are club members. Volunteers will be sitting at the side tables so bring your calendars and cheque books to the meeting. Our

membership fees are staying the same: \$25 for adults, \$20 for seniors (65 years and older) and children (12 to 18 years of age) while children under 12 are \$15.

You can postdate your cheques but if you are signing up for the Silver Star trip in January, your cheque needs to be dated December 1st or earlier to meet hotel's payment requirements. For the March 5 weekend trip to Manning Park, we need your cheque dated February 1st, 2016

PARKING: Our usual parking lot is no longer available!
 Our new parking is the southeast corner of the Lougheed Town Centre Mall right at the corner of Austin and North Road. This corner of the parking lot is across the street from the Esso station and kitty corner to Denny's. It is NOT the under covered parking lot...sorry folks. The Mall's administration is allowing us to park for an extended period here for free only on trip dates.
