## Happy Holidays everyone,

Thank you to the brave members who ventured out to our last meeting to hear a wonderful presentation given by two members of the Coquitlam Search and Rescue team. Their talk reminded us to be prepared for all conditions when out on the trails hiking, snowshoeing or skiing. The ten essentials that everyone should carry when on their outdoor adventures are:

- 1 Flashlights or headlamps and spare batteries
- 2 Extra food and water
- 3 Extra clothing (rain, wind and water protection)
- 4 Navigational aids (map, compass, GPS, mobile phone)
- 5 Fire starter (water proof matches, mag striker)
- 6 First Aid kit
- 7 Emergency shelter (emergency blanket or even a garbage bag)
- 8 Sun and bug protection
- 9 Pocket knife
- 10 Signaling Device (whistles, air horn, bear bangers)

While all of the ten essentials are extremely important, even more important is to tell someone where you are going and when you should be back. Let's stay safe this year in the great outdoors!

Please Note: Our next two meetings do not fall on the first Monday of the month. Our first meeting in the new year will be on Monday, January 8 in rooms 5/6 of the Pinetree Community Center. The event will begin at 7:30 with a short presentation about snowshoeing including equipment
